By-Law 2017-77

Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2013-164 to Provide for the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Waste, Recyclable Material and Other Waste within Norfolk County.

WHEREAS Sections 5 and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of the Municipal Council shall be exercised by by-law, unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise and that the municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County deems it necessary to amend the Waste Management By-Law 2013-164 to provide for the collection of waste and recycling at condominium corporations.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Waste Management By-Law 2013-164 be amended by adding the following Section 2.1:
 - z. "Condominium Corporation" means the corporation that is the owner of lands and premises established for residential condominium forms of ownership and use, and includes any property manager or other designated third party acting on behalf of such Condominium Corporation.
2. That the Waste Management By-Law 2013-164 Section 3.1 (b) be amended by adding after "occupied by that person" the words: "with the exception of approved condominium corporations that have completed the necessary application for waste collection services and have been approved for collection".
3. That Waste Management By-Law 2013-164 Section 3.1 (c) be amended by adding after "pedestrians or both" the words: "with the exception of approved condominium corporations that have completed the necessary application for waste collection services and have been approved for collection".
4. That Waste Management By-Law 2013-164, Section 4.5 be deleted and replaced with Waste Collection Services to Condominium Corporations will be provided subject to meeting the criteria established in the *Technical Guidelines for Waste Collection Services for Condominium Corporations*;

5. That the effective date of this By-Law shall be the date of passage thereof.
