By-Law 2018-04

Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2010-107 to Regulate Election Signs in Norfolk County.

WHEREAS Sections 5 and 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended*, provide that the powers of the Municipal Council shall be exercised by by-law, unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise and that the municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority;

AND WHEREAS Section 10(2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended*, provides that the municipality may pass by-laws respecting structures, including fences and signs;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend By-Law 2010-107 as a result of amendments made to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* by the *Municipal Elections Modernization Act, 2016 (Bill 181)*.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law 2010-107 being a By-Law to Regulate Election Signs in Norfolk County be amended through the deletion of Section 5.1 and replacement therein with the following:

“5.1 Election Signs shall not be erected or displayed prior to 9:00 a.m. thirty days prior to the Day of Election in the year of a Municipal Election or By-Election.”

2. That the effective date of this By-Law shall be the date of passage thereof.
