

**Exemption Request regarding Service Connections in Port Dover
Requirements of Norfolk County Zoning By-Law 1-Z-2014**

Section 3.9.5 of the Norfolk County Zoning By-Law 1-Z12014 states:

“That the General Manager of the Public Works and Environmental Services Department has the discretion to waive the requirement for minimum services where a municipal water supply or municipal sanitary sewer system is not available or require that the municipal water supply or municipal sanitary sewer system be extended to service the property. [8-Z-2017]”

The General Manager, Public Works can support that the municipal water supply is not currently available to the following property or properties:

Subject to the conditions listed below, the General Manager, Public Works (1) waives the requirement for connection to the municipal water supply in order to facilitate the construction at the property(ies) listed above; and (2) permits the installation of servicing infrastructure at the time of construction at the property(ies) listed above, if desired by the landowner.

CONDITIONS:

- Any water supply infrastructure installed at the time of construction will remain in the "OFF" position until such time as the County determines there is sufficient water capacity/availability
- In accordance with the requirements of By-Law 1-2014 (Section 3.9, Minimum Services), a connection to the municipal water supply will be required when the County confirms there is sufficient water capacity/availability
- Pending connection to the municipal water system, an alternative water supply must be provided as per the requirements of the Building Department
