



**The Corporation of Norfolk County  
By-Law 2021-70**

**Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2011-189, as Amended, to Regulate Parking within Norfolk County. (Schedule "A", On-Street Parking)**

**WHEREAS** Sections 5 and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of the Municipal Council shall be exercised by by-law, unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise and that the municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 27 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws in respect of a highway over which it has jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County deems it necessary to amend By-Law 2011-189, as amended, Schedule 'A' On-Street Parking, to introduce to extend the restricted no parking signs on Oakwood Avenue, Simcoe (Ward 5).

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT Schedule "A" of By-Law 2011-189 be amended through the addition of the entry in Schedule "A" of By-Law 2021-70.
2. That the effective date of this By-Law shall be the date of passage.
